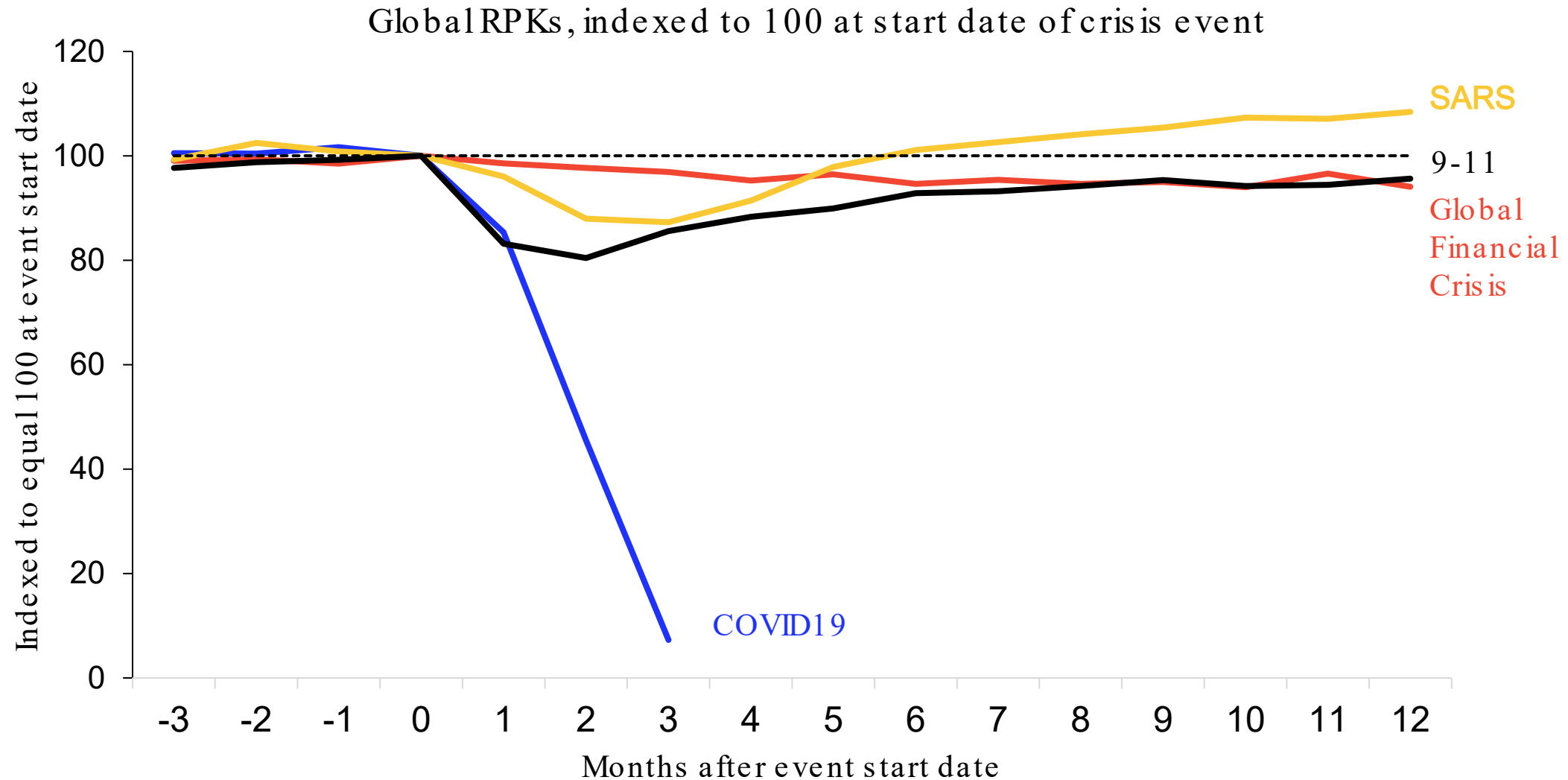


Worldwide impact: 33% of fleet grounded in Sept 2020 (vs. ~65% in April 2020)



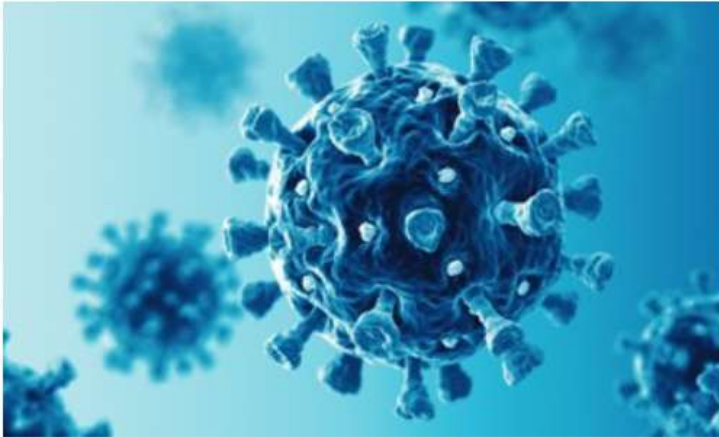
Depth of COVID19 impact far exceeds previous crises

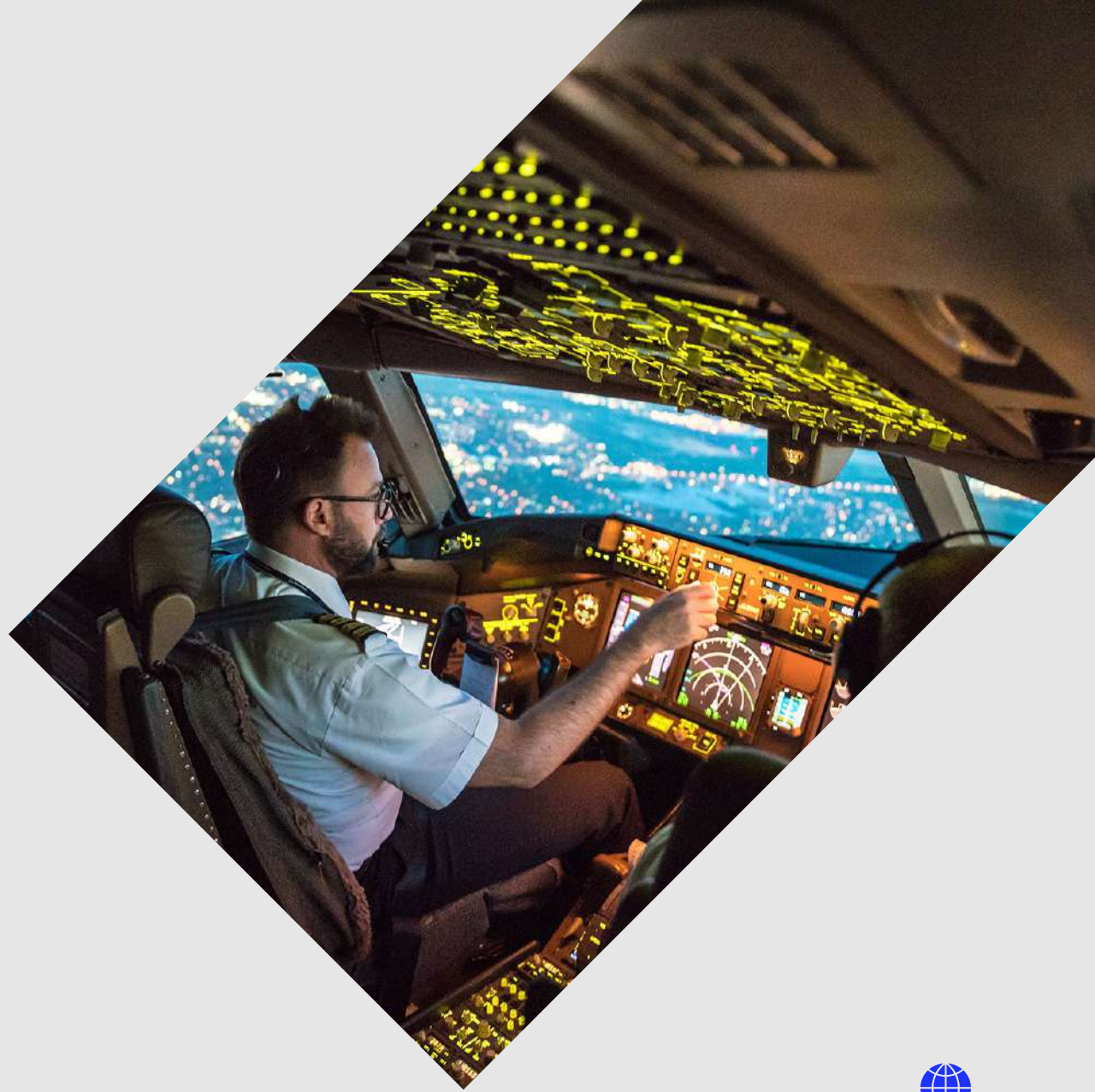

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What is CBTA?

Definitions from ICAO

Competency. A dimension of human **performance** that is used to reliably predict successful **performance** on the job. A competency is manifested and observed through behaviors that mobilize the relevant knowledge, skills and attitudes to carry out activities or tasks under specified conditions.

Competency -based training and assessment . Training and assessment that are characterized by a **performance** orientation, emphasis on standards of **performance** and their measurement, and the development of training to the specified **performance** standards.

Pilot Competencies

APK	Application of Procedures and compliance with regulations
FPA	Aeroplane Flight Path Management, automation
FPM	Aeroplane Flight Path Management, manual control

PSD	Problem Solving and Decision Making

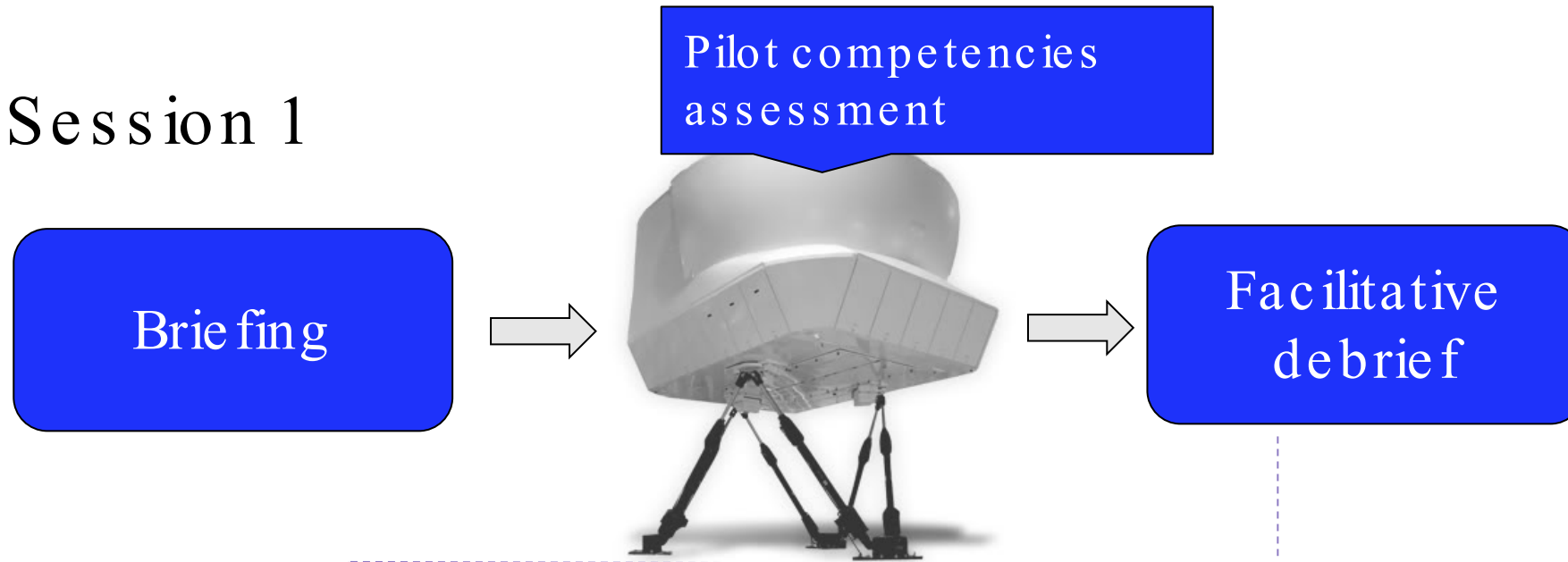
Evidence-based Training

Training and assessment based on **operational data** that is characterized by **developing and assessing the overall capability** of a trainee **across a range of core competencies** rather than by measuring the performance in individual events or maneuvers.

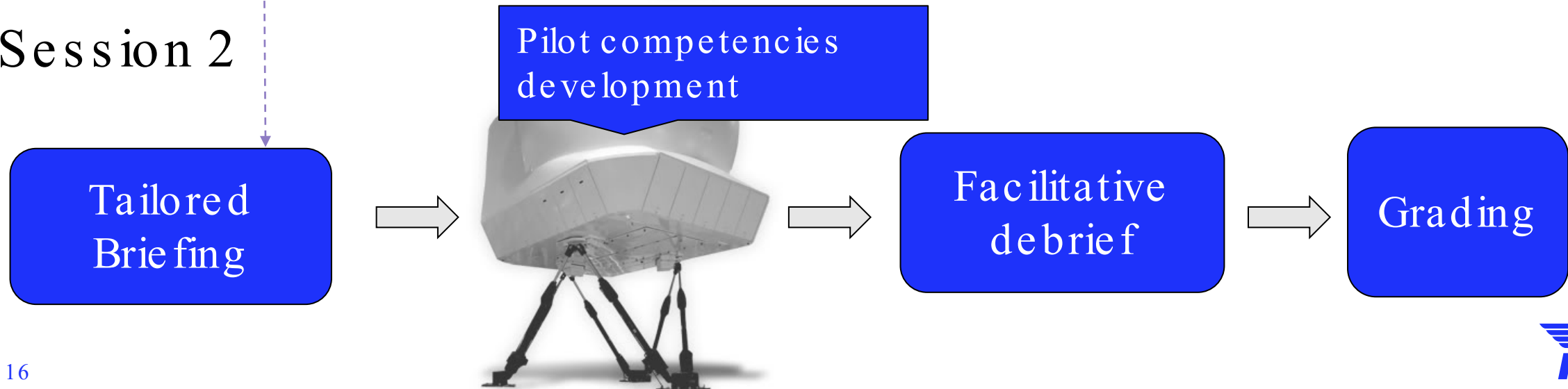

EBT module content

ICAO doc 9995 Manual of Evidence Based Training	
Phase	Objective
Evaluation (EVAL)	a) observe and assess flight crew competency; b) collect data to further develop and validate the effectiveness of the training system; and c) identify individual training needs.
Manoeuvre Training (M.T)	The purpose of the manoeuvres training phase is to practise and develop the handling skills necessary to fly critical flight manoeuvres, in order that they are maintained to a defined level of proficiency, according to predetermined performance criteria as established by the operator or training organization.
Scenario Based Training (SBT)	The purpose of the scenario-based training phase is to develop, retain and practice the competencies for effective management of threats and errors to enhance the crew's ability to cope with both predictable and unforeseen situations.

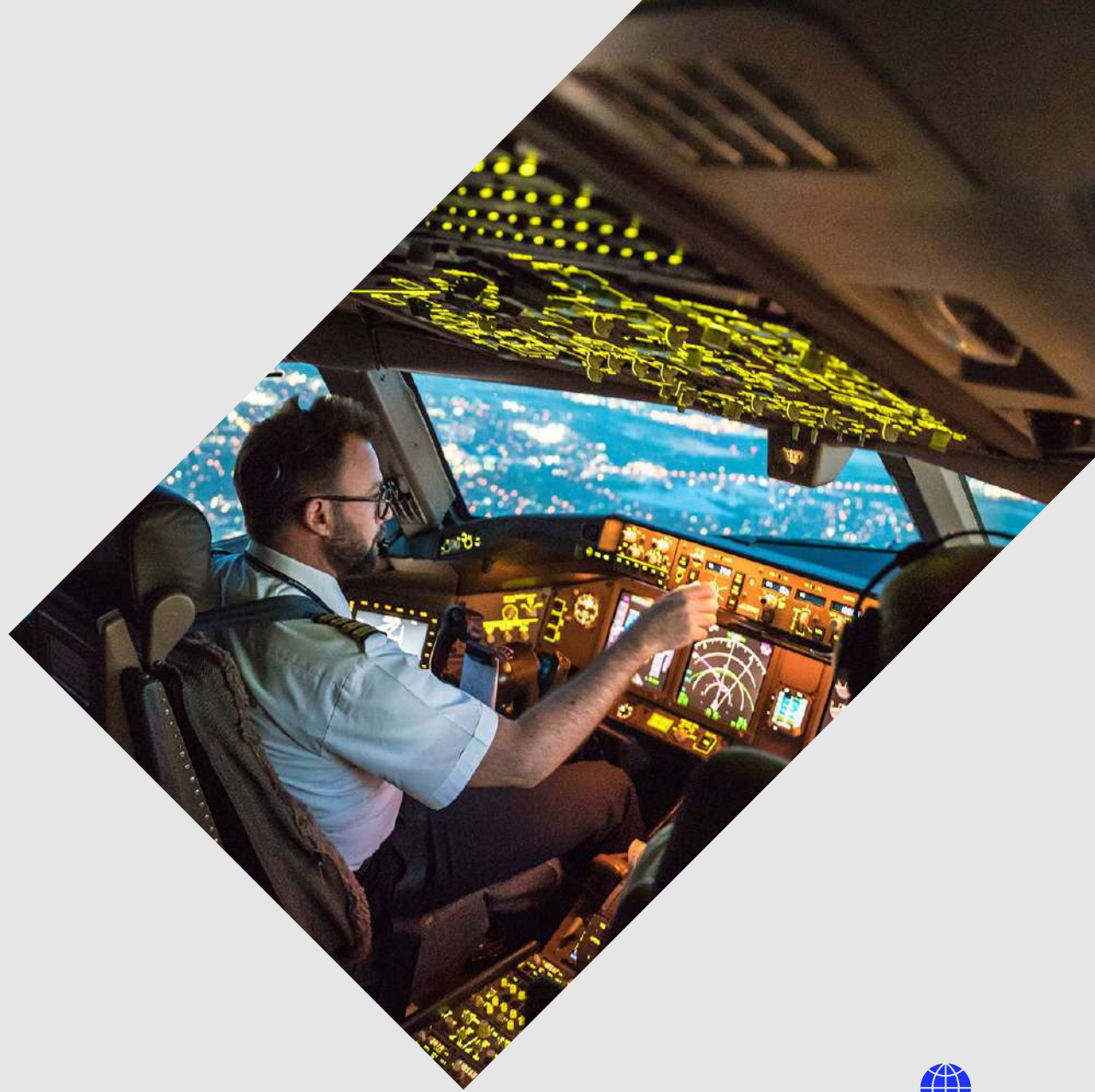
Evidence-based Training (EBT)

Take away, EBT is :

- An alternative to traditional recurrent training and checking
- Competency-Based Training and Assessment (CBTA) program
- Data driven (operational data)
- Rebalancing training volumes vs checking volumes
- Promoting learning from positive performance
- Reinforcing pilot's resilience

- Deliver awareness workshop(s) to top management and operational staff.
- Assess organization (AOC-ATO) needs.
- Propose options and associated EBT implementation plan.
- Buy-in from your CAA.
- Support internal EBT awareness and communication plan.

IATA EBT consultancy service

EBT Implementation support

- Support the definition and implementation of your pilot and instructor competency grading system.
- Train and assess your EBT instructor core group in accordance to your competency performance standards.
- Support EBT program design (including malfunction and approach type clustering).
- Propose technical solutions for training data collection and analysis.

IATA EBT consultancy service

EBT Monitoring

- Review training effectiveness upon receipt of sufficient training system data.
- Adjustment and continuous improvement of the training program (based on training system feedback).
